## SALARY PROGRESSION AS PART OF THE CHARTERED TEACHER PROGRAMME

- 1. As part of the further development of the 2001 Agreement it has been agreed that candidates for Chartered Teacher status will receive one salary increment on the Chartered Teacher scale for every two modules successfully completed. Agreement has now been reached on the mechanism for putting into payment salary increments for those progressing through the Chartered Teacher scale.
- 2. On attaining a module as part of the Chartered Teacher programme, the teacher shall ensure that a copy of the certificate or written notice of the award from the provider is passed to the employing authority without delay. On the completion of the 2nd, 4th, 6th, 8th, 10th and 12<sup>th</sup> modules or equivalent accreditation, the employing authority shall apply an additional increment(s) with effect from the first day of the month following the date shown on the certificate or notice of award. Former Assistant Principal Teachers and Senior Teachers assimilated to Point 3 of the Chartered Teacher scale will remain at that point until the completion of the 8<sup>th</sup> Chartered Teacher module or equivalent accreditation. In addition the GTC(S) will confirm with the individual local authorities, the names of individuals who have completed modules as part of the Chartered Teacher programme. Any payment will await GTC confirmation but will be backdated to the first day of the month following the date shown on the certificate or notice of award.
