(2) <u>Welcome</u> – The Chair welcomed members to the meeting and noted the apologies received.

(3) SNCT Annual General Meeting

The Teachers' side undertook to notify their finalised membership for this year via the Joint Secretaries.

(d) The SNCT will continue to use Condie's, (COSLA auditors) if required.

- (4) <u>Note of previous meeting 28 January 2009</u> This note was <u>agreed</u> and it was also <u>noted</u> that there had been no further Joint Chairs' meetings since 14 January 2009.
- (5) Reports of SNCT Working Groups:
 - (a) The Report of the Conditions of Service Working Group was <u>agreed</u> and it was <u>noted</u> that the guidance for Jobsizing co-ordinators should be finalised as soon as possible to enable training on the changes to be progressed. The Practical Classes list was also agreed, subject to further discussion around the inclusion of Product Design.
 - (b) The Report of the Review of LNCTs Working Group was <u>agreed</u>, subject to minor amendments to be finalised by the Joint Secretaries. Thanks were extended to Drew Morrice and Alistair Farquhar for their work in producing the Teacher Workload paper which was also <u>agreed</u> and further remitted to the Joint Secretaries to finalise and publish. Michael Kellet, on behalf of the full SNCT offered thanks to May Ferries for her chairmanship of the working group and her participation in wider SNCT activities over the years as she is stepping down from SNCT duties.
- (6) <u>Chartered Teacher Paper</u> Thanks were extended to the members of the sub group for their work in coming to agreement on the final paper. The paper was agreed in principle and warmly welcomed by all sides, subject to final check to ensure consistency with the revised Standard for Chartered Teacher. The paper was further remitted to the Joint Secretaries to be finalised and issued as an SNCT circular by the end of June 2009.
- (7) The outcome of SNCT Appeal SNCT/AP/12 was noted.
- (8) <u>Revised Appeals Procedure</u> Thanks were extended to Louise Wilson for her work in streamlining the process. This was <u>agreed</u> and remitted to the Joint Secretaries for finalising and issuing as an SNCT Circular.
- (9) <u>SNCT Circulars</u> The following circulars were <u>homologated</u>:
 - (a) SNCT 09/09 Hours of Work and Annual Leave for Educational Psychologists and Quality Improvement Officers. Although this circular was homologated, the Employers' Side wished to <u>note</u> their disappointment that their formal request for paragraph 5.12 in Part 2 of the SNCT Handbook to now be removed from the Handbook could not be agreed by the Teachers' Side.
 - (b) SNCT 09/10 The Position of Teachers formerly Assistant Principal Teachers and Senior Teachers.
- (10) <u>Memorandum of Understanding with GTCS</u> Thanks were extended to Drew Morrice for his work in drafting this with the GTCS. All <u>agreed</u> this would improve

the Joint working of the two organisations. The paper was agreed in principle and further remitted to the Joint Secretaries for finalisation and publication.

- (11) <u>SNCT Calendar of Meetings 2009 2010</u> The draft calendar was <u>noted</u> and welcomed by all sides as advance notice of future meetings. Joint Secretaries were asked to finalise the calendar.
- (12) AOCB There was no other business to be discussed.
