Update regarding Payroll Specification

Dear Colleague

The SNCT Joint Secretaries recently met with local authority payroll providers regarding the above. At this meeting we agreed that an update would be issued to employers.

The payroll providers are now aware of the requirements to automate the specification and have agreed to discuss these requirements with employers. If there are any major issues reported by the payroll providers or employers the SNCT will consider these.

The SNCT wishes a fully automated process to deliver the pay specification to be in place for the beginning of the 2016/17 academic session. We will work with payroll providers in order for this be achieved. In the meantime the Joint Secretaries note that some authorities will be using certain areas of the specification but some will also continue with local practice to deliver the current pay provisions set out in the SNCT Handbook.

It should be noted that the Joint Secretaries will meet with SPPA to discuss the calculations related to pensionable service. The SNCT is also working at making changes to the SNCT Handbook to take account of the pay specification.
