#### Short-term supply teachers in Shetland Hours of engagement with effect from 15 April 2019

# (a) Secondary Settings

The hours of engagement of short-term supply teachers in secondary settings for a full day or half day:

Monday to Thursday: Full Day	Friday: Full Day	Monday to Thursday morning: Half Day	Monday to Thursday afternoon: Half Day
6.42 hours	4.58 hours	3.67 hours	2.75 hours

On Fridays short-term supply teachers will be engaged for the full day only.

## (b) Non-Asymmetric Primary Settings:

The engagement of short-term supply teachers in non-asymmetric primary settings for a full day or half day:

On Fridays short-term supply teachers will be engaged for the full day only.

Please note:

- 1. The figures for secondary schools have been determined with close reference to the length of the pupil days within the asymmetric structure.
- 2. The figures for primary schools have been determined taking account of the current morning and afternoon configurations for all primary pupils in non-asymmetric and asymmetric settings respectively.
- 3. The total hours payable to a short-term supply teacher over the timesheet period will be rounded up to the nearest quarter of an hour.
- 4. In all cases, the short-term supply teacher will receive an automatic 10% pay uplift for preparation and correction time.
